



# American Rescue Plan Act State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds

Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF), a part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), delivers \$350 billion to state, local and Tribal governments.

ARPA SLFRF provides a substantial infusion of resources to support response to and recovery from the Covid-19 public health emergency.

## Funding Objectives

- Fight the pandemic and support families and businesses struggling with its public health and economic impacts
- Maintain vital public services even amid declines in revenue
- Build a strong, resilient and equitable recovery by making investments supporting long-term growth and opportunity

## DOR Distributions to Non-Entitlement Units (NEUs) in 2021

- 1,828 eligible Wisconsin NEUs
- 1,825 payments issued totaling \$205,769,426.76
- Three NEUs declined funding, two forwarding their allocation to the state of Wisconsin
- 99.99% distributed



### Support Public Health Response

Fund COVID-19 mitigation efforts, medical expenses, behavioral healthcare, and public health and safety staff



### Replace Public Sector Revenue Loss

Use funds to provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the pandemic (offering a standard allowance for revenue loss up to \$10 million)



### Water and Sewer Infrastructure

Make necessary investments to improve access to clean drinking water and invest in wastewater and stormwater infrastructure



### Address Negative Economic Impacts

Respond to economic harms to workers, families, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector



### Premium Pay for Essential Workers

Offer additional support to those who have and will bear the greatest health risks because of their service in critical sectors



### Broadband Infrastructure

Make necessary investments to provide unserved or underserved locations with new or expanded broadband access
