INSTRUCTIONS FOR LIQUOR/WINE SALESPERSON'S PERMIT

→ WHO NEEDS A LIQUOR/WINE SALESPERSON'S PERMIT

Any person in Wisconsin who solicits orders for or engages in the sale of liquor/wine for future delivery on behalf of the manufacturer or permittee must have this permit.

→ TO OBTAIN A LIQUOR/WINE SALESPERSON'S PERMIT

Send your completed application to: Wisconsin Department of Revenue, Excise Tax Section 6-107, PO Box 8900, Madison, WI 53708-8900.

→ BUSINESS TAX REGISTRATION (BTR) FEE

A \$20 BTR fee applies to all person's who apply for liquor/wine salesperson's permit.

Exceptions – The \$20 BTR fee is not due with this application if:

- You held any active permit or certificate on December 31, 1995, issued by the department that is covered by the BTR provisions.
- You paid the \$20 BTR fee with a previous application for another permit or certificate.

→ BUSINESS TAX REGISTRATION (BTR) RENEWAL

The department will send the Business Tax Registration (BTR) renewal notice when the permits and certificates subject to BTR provisions approach their expiration date. The expiration date will vary from taxpayer to taxpayer. Normally, the expiration date is two years from the end of the month in which you applied for your permit/certificate.
